

2x2 plus 4x4 Bell Schedules

NOTE that the bell schedule for upper School students involves 11th and 12th graders in taking 2 long blocked classes each term while 9th and 10th graders are on a different 4 x 4 block schedule.

Students in the Lower school take 4 classes each day each term plus participate in a daily Advisory. Students in the Upper school take 2 longer-blocked lasses each day each term plus also participate in a daily advisory.
